

Rondo a Capriccio

"Die Wut über einen verlorenen Groschen"

Ludwig van Beethoven

Op. 129

Measures 1-7 of the Rondo a Capriccio. The piece is in 2/4 time with a key signature of one sharp (F#). The first system shows the beginning of the piece with a piano (*p*) dynamic.
